



2007 Wisconsin AAU Regional Track & Field Championships

- Sanction:** Wisconsin AAU
- When:** Saturday, June 30th, 2007 7:30AM Registration/check-in 8:30AM Field 9:30AM Track
- Location:** South Milwaukee High School , 801 15th Avenue South Milwaukee, WI 53172
- Directions:** I-94 Exit College Avenue, East 3 ½ miles to 15th Avenue (YMCA) South (R) on 15th to East (L) on Oak Creek Parkway
- Entry Deadline:** Friday, June 15nd , 2007
- Entry Fees:** **\$18.00 per athlete.** All entries will be made online. You must pay by credit card online when you enter the meet. Entry confirmation will be sent when online entry fee has been received.
- Registration:** **REGISTRATION WILL BE ONLINE ONLY** at <http://adkinstrak.com/> Any questions please contact Brian Schneider at 414-243-3856.
- Proof of Age:** **Must be available at meet if needed.** Failure to provide may result in disqualification. Valid proof of age documents are a birth certificate or drivers license.
- Eligibility:** Open to all 2007 AAU members from the age divisions indicated. No athlete will be allowed to participate without AAU membership. You may register online at <http://www.aauathletics.org/>
- Entry Limits:** Primary thru Midget are limited to three(3) events only including relays. Sub-Youth thru Young may enter four(4) events only, including relays. Entry in a relay, either as a principal runner or an alternate member, would be considered an entry for the purpose of this rule.
- Facilities:** The facility is an all weather surface. 1/4" spikes or flats required. Shot and Discus areas are concrete and will require flats. Restrooms available, concessions on site, parking adjacent to track. **One area of the facility is under construction, please respect the roped off areas.**
- Awards:** Medals will be awarded to the top four(4) in each age group. Relay to top three(3). Medals will be tallied after the meet and sent out to the club coaches for distribution. Unattached athletes will be sent theirs individually. **No medals will be handed out at the meet.**
- Nationals:** Top four(4) qualifiers in both individual and relay events will move on to the Junior Olympic Games in Knoxville, Tennessee July 28 - Aug 4, 2007. Registration for the National meet will be online at <http://www.aauathletics.org/>
- Admission:** \$3.00 for adults, \$1.00 for children, 3 and under free. Coaches or athletes with valid 2007 AAU cards are admitted free.

Relays: Relays will only be contested in the following age groups; Bantam, Midget, Youth, Intermediate, and Young. **Note:** Sub-Bantams can run as Bantams, Sub-Midgets can run as Midgets, and Sub Youth can run as Youth. All relay teams must wear identical uniforms and have their own batons.

*Athletes who are eighteen(18) years of age thru the final day of the National Track & Field Championships shall be eligible to compete in the Young Men/Women division thru that Track & Field meet. Anyone who reaches their nineteenth (19) birthday on or before the last day of the National Championship Meet(AAU Junior Olympic Games), are not eligible to compete in any qualifying meets.

Order of Events: *Steeplechase, Racewalk, Pole Vault, and Multi-events will not be contested at this meet.
